Question	Response
How can you see all GHG data collected?	You can see all GHG data collected in CAM by accessing the Carbon Dashboard, navigating to the "Metrics" tab for detailed emissions data, and using the "Reporting" section to view and filter carbon performance, emission metrics, energy consumption, and carbon targets dashboards.
How many suppliers can you include in this system?	There is no limitation
What does Procurement Risk mean?	The Procurement Risk contextualizes the heatmap results to the customer's network (e.g. spend or criticality are self-defined factors). For example, a supplier representing a high % of spend will represent a higher final risk for the customer. Note: this is a voluntary entry and allows incorporation of customer's information to calculate overall risk level, and a more accurate recommendations.
Could you please confirm whether the datapoints distinguish between “committed” targets and “targets that have been set”? And how can I filter my suppliers on ratings with this information ?	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Does performance actually improve?Yes, but it's progressive.44% of companies in the network show measurable improvement in their carbon management score each year.As they move up the scale, they shift from qualitative (having a policy) to quantitative (reporting actual tons of CO2).2. How much decarbonization is realized?The "real" decarbonization happens when a supplier moves from Intermediate to Advanced/Leader.At lower levels, they are just "counting" emissions. At higher levels, they are required to set Science-Based Targets and show absolute GHG reductions. This is where the actual atmospheric impact occurs.3. What are the biggest impact steps?If you want to move the needle in your supply chain, focus on these two transitions: The "Target Setting" Jump and The "Reporting" Pillar (50% of the score) (Beginner → Intermediate)

Question	Response
<p>Can suppliers report both short term and long term decarbonization targets?</p>	<p>Yes, suppliers can report both short-term (near-term) and long-term decarbonization targets.</p>
<p>I don't understand if Carbon questionnaire is a part of EV rating questionnaire or not , could you please explain it ?</p>	<p>It is integrated but distinct. A supplier typically fills out one comprehensive questionnaire, but the data generates two results: a general Sustainability Medal and a specific Carbon Maturity Level.</p> <p>Integrated: The Carbon questionnaire is embedded within the standard EcoVadis Sustainability Rating. When a supplier completes the "Environment" section, they are answering the core Carbon questions.</p> <p>Distinct: For companies using the Carbon Action Manager, this data is extracted to create a separate Carbon Scorecard. This scorecard focuses purely on GHG management (Commitment, Actions, and Reporting) and assigns a specific Maturity Level (e.g., Intermediate, Leader).</p>
